## STEPUP SCHOOL'S SPRING SHOWS 23.–25.5.2026

StepUp School's Spring Shows are in Pasila Sports Hall (Pasilan Urheiluhalli, Radiokatu 22, Helsinki) on May 23rd - May 25th. Almost all of the dance schools groups, Special training programmes and groups which have succeeded at dance competitions will perform. For the most part, each group will perform only in one show. ### Showtimes:

Saturday 23rd at 13.30 and 18.00

Sunday 24th at 11.00 and 15.30

Monday 25th at 18.00

The Saturday afternoon and Sunday shows last approximately 1–1.5 hours. The Saturday evening show lasts approximately 1.5–2 hours and the Monday shows lasts approximately 2–2.5 hours. Shows have no intermission.

**The audience can enter the stands with an entrance ticket already during dress rehearsals, so we recommend arriving early to avoid last-minute congestion.** We hope the audience will support and watch the entire show, but if necessary, the audience will be able to move in and out during the applause breaks and speeches provided they keep their ticket with them. **Standing and moving in the stands during performances is prohibited.**

Programmes (Käsiohjelma) of each show will be published later on our website. There will be no hand-out programme leaflets at the venue, but there are posters on the wall. Print out your own copy of the programme at home or take a picture of the programme on the wall with your mobile phone or follow the programme from our website.

### BUYING TICKETS - IT IS CHEAPER IN ADVANCE!

Ticket sales will start on May 4th at 10.00. Tickets are sold at [Lippuagentti's webstore](#). You can print out your tickets at home or order them to your email. Tickets are not sold at the dance school.

Places are numbered and each show has its own tickets. All B-sections of the stands are at the lower level and A-sections are at the higher level. The stage is in front of section B2. You can see the stage well from all sections of the stands. However, there is a minor visual barrier from the glass railing on the first two rows of sections A1, A2 and A3.

The performers don't need tickets to any shows of the day in which they are performing themselves, but there are no reserved seats for them, but they will sit on the floor next to the stage. Children under the age of 3 don't need a ticket if they are sitting on their parents lap.

### Ticket prices at Lippuagentti.fi

adults € 21 (includes Lippuagentti's commission € 2.50)

children (3-14 yrs) € 16 (includes Lippuagentti's commission € 2.50)

Ticket sales at Lippuagentti will end 1.5 hours before the beginning of each show.

### Ticket prices at the door (provided there are tickets left)

adults € 25

children (3-14 yrs) € 20

**We recommend buying the tickets in advance, when they are also cheaper.** Ticket sales at the door starts one hour before each show and only tickets to the next show are sold at the door.

### **Ticket packages**

If you are coming to see three or more shows, it is possible to buy a ticket package (Lippupaketti). Ticket packages are sold only at [Lippuagentti's webstore](#). **PÄIVITÄ LINKKI** When you have chosen the package you want, go to your shopping cart (Ostoskori) to give your contact information and to choose which shows you want to include in the ticket package and what section of the stands you want to sit in. After giving this information, you will pay for the tickets. You will get a confirmation of the payment in your email. The tickets will be delivered to your email within four weekdays. The sale of ticket packages ends on **May 20th at 23.00**. PLEASE NOTE! **In case you also bought single tickets, don't forget to print them or send them to your email after the payment.**

Ticket package orders are processed manually in the order in which they arrive. The online sales of the tickets is open during this process. We are not able to guarantee that you will get your tickets from the section you wished for. However you can see the stage well from all sections of the stands. There is a minor visual barrier from the glass railing on the first two rows of sections A1, A2 and A3.

### **Ticket package prices:**

Ticket package for 3 different shows: € 44,20 (includes Lippuagentti's commission € 2,50)

Ticket package for 4 different shows: € 54,80 (includes Lippuagentti's commission € 3)

Ticket package for 5 different shows: € 63,20 (includes Lippuagentti's commission € 3)

Ticket package for 6 different shows: € 69,60 (includes Lippuagentti's commission € 3)

Possible delivery fees and payment method fees are added to prices.

Ticket packages are meant for people who want to see at least three different shows. They are not group tickets. However one person can buy several ticket packages at the same time. There is no difference in ticket package prices for children and adults.

### **Guardian tickets**

Guardians of the children, who perform in age groups 3-4 years and 5-6 -years, are entitled to one (1) guardian ticket per child free of charge to the show in which their child performs. Guardian will get this ticket in Pasila Sports Hall at the registration desk. Guardian tickets obligate parents to take care of their child in Pasila Sports Hall, so it is not actually a free ticket. Guardians will have reserved seats at the B1-section of the stands. If the pupil is 6 years old, but attends classes which are to children 7-9 years old, must the guardian contact our office in advance, no later than May 13th, by email ([school@stepup.fi](mailto:school@stepup.fi)) in order to get a guardian ticket at Pasila Sports Hall.

### **COSTUMES, EXTRA REHEARSALS AND DRESS REHEARSALS**

Shows will be rehearsed during regular dance classes. The last classes of the season will be different because of this. Teachers will inform each group about their costumes, and dress rehearsal times. All groups don't have dress rehearsals. Dress rehearsals and possible extra rehearsals are free of charge. If your teacher organises extra rehearsals, he/she will inform you about them. Dress rehearsals are open only to the performers, ticket holders of that particular show and guardians with a guardian ticket. [Dress rehearsal \(kenraali\) schedules](#) and [teachers' own information leaflets](#) mostly in Finnish (opettajien tiedotteita) will be published on our website.

### **PERFORMERS' REGISTRATION**

When performers come to Pasila Sports Hall, they must first register at the registration desk. This takes place at the ground floor. After registration they will be able to go to the dressing rooms and dress rehearsals. Performers must come in good time in order to have time for the registration and other preparations. If you have your StepUp card with your name written on it with you, it will make the registration faster. Only performers and guardian ticket holders are allowed in the dressing rooms. It is recommended that you put costumes, hair and make-up on already at home. When the show is running only

performers of that particular show are allowed in the dressing rooms. Performers will go to the stands and to the stage directly from the dressing rooms. Please leave your outer garments and shoes to the dressing rooms. Don't forget to take some snacks/lunch with you. There is also a cafeteria in Pasila Sports Hall.

### PICTURES AND VIDEOS OF THE SHOWS

StepUp School's principles of a safer space are also valid for Spring Shows. However, filming the performances and publishing the footage is allowed. We will take pictures and videos of the shows for dance schools purposes and possibly use them later for advertising, eg. on our website.

### ARRIVING TO THE PASILA SPORTS HALL

Please note that there is **only limited parking space** near the Pasila Sports Hall. **We recommend using public transport.** You can find routes and schedules at <https://www.hsl.fi/en>. The Mall of Tripla's car park is about 15-20 minutes' walk away. Buses 23 and 59 and tram 9 take you from Pasila station to Pasila Sports Hall. If you arrive by train, Ilmala station is the closest. From there, it is about a 10-minute walk to the Sports Hall.

### OTHER INSTRUCTIONS

The audience enters Pasila Sports Hall from the main door, at the top floor of the building, which is located right next to the parking area. Performers and guardians will enter from the ground floor (steps down from the parking area). After registration only performers and guardian ticket holders can remain at the ground floor. After the show the main exit out is straight from the stands (left from the audience). Please remember to keep the walkways clear!

Tickets will be checked at the stands' door. There is only one entrance for the audience to the stands and it may take a small while to get in. Please stay calm, all ticket holders will get into their seats.

Pasila Sports Hall does not have actual disabled seats in the stands. You can buy a seat in any section of the stands. Our staff will guide you to a place reserved for wheelchairs. The assistant of a person in a wheelchair does not need their own ticket.

### LOST AND FOUND ITEMS

After the shows, lost and found items will be transferred to the Helsinki dance school. You can inquire about them by email [school@stepup.fi](mailto:school@stepup.fi) next week after the shows. Please include exact characteristics of lost property and your own contact information. Lost and found items will be stored for two months, after which unclaimed lost and found items will be donated to charity.
